POLICY:

It is the policy of the Beach Cities Health District ("District") to implement a building occupant waste reduction and recycling program that addresses the separation, collection and storage of materials for recycling and diversion from landfill disposal or incineration for the property located at 514 North Prospect Avenue, Redondo Beach, California.

BCHD Occupant Recycling program will meet the following objectives:

- Address the separation, collection and storage of (at a minimum) paper, glass, plastics, cardboard, old corrugated cardboard (OCC), metals, batteries and fluorescent light bulbs.
- Collect and recycle at least 95% of the batteries used and collect and recycle at least 95% of the fluorescent light bulbs used.
