NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CALLING FOR BIDS

BEACH CITIES HEALTH DISTRICT, Redondo Beach, CA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the above-named California health district ("District") will receive up to, but not later than the below-stated date and time, sealed Bid Proposals for the construction work for the Project generally described as: **Diamond Street and Flagler Lane Bike Path Project.**

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Sitework & Street Improvements at existing Diamond Street and Flagler Lane alleyway for a new dedicated bike path. Scope of work includes site demolition, grading of hillside, new retaining walls, paving, graphics, signage, striping, curbs, landscaping, utilities, and street lighting.

- Estimated construction cost - \$1,200,000
- The work is currently anticipated to begin January 27, 2023.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BID PROPOSALS: December 14, 2022 no later than 2:00 PM.

BID AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: Bid and Contract Documents will be available beginning on November 14, 2022, and will be posted on the District's website at <https://www.bchd.org/rfq>. Bidders may view the Bid and Contract Documents online and download the documents at no cost to user.

REGISTRATION:

Contractors planning to submit a bid must register with the District, to be placed on the "Plan Holders List" to receive notifications of addenda and changes to bidding schedule. By November 14, 2022, a link to register will also be posted on the District's website <https://www.bchd.org/rfq>.

SUBMISSION OF BID PROPOSALS: Bids will only be accepted at the following location:

Any bids submitted to the District by any other means will not be accepted and will be rejected.

Bidder must enclose their proposal in a sealed envelope; type or print on the envelope "Bid Proposal for" followed by the project title and the bidder's name and address. The envelope may be mailed, hand delivered, or delivered by courier or package delivery service, so long as it is received by the District no later than the deadline for submission of bid proposals.

Bids will be publicly opened and read shortly after the deadline for submission of bid proposals. Bids received after the specified date and time will not be opened or read.

1. Licenses. Contractors are required to have a **Class: A (General Engineering) or Class B (General Contracting)** license at the time of bid submission.

2. Registration with DIR. Pursuant to Labor Code §1725.5, all bidders and their subcontractors of any tier must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations in order to submit a bid, be listed in a bid proposal, or engage in the performance of this contract.

3. Bid Security. Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by Bid Security in an amount not less than **ten percent (10%)** of the maximum amount of the Bid Proposal, inclusive of any additive Bid Alternates. Failure of any Bid Proposal to be accompanied by Bid Security in the form and in the amount required shall render such Bid Proposal to be non-responsive and rejected by the District.

4. No Withdrawal of Bid Proposals. Bid Proposals shall not be withdrawn by any Bidder for a period of **ninety (90) days** after the opening of Bid Proposals. During this time, all Bidders shall guarantee prices quoted in their respective Bid Proposals.

5. Job Walk. The District will conduct a **MANDATORY** Job Walk on **November 18, 2022** beginning at **10:00 AM**. Job Walk location: Café Room, 514 N. Prospect Avenue, Redondo Beach, CA 90277. If Bidder's attendance at the Job Walk is mandatory, the Bid Proposal submitted by a Bidder whose representative(s) did not attend the entirety of the Mandatory Job Walk will be rejected by the District as non-responsive. **All Attending Contractors MUST meet the District representatives at the job walk location. Bidders will be escorted onto the job site from that location.**

6. Contract Time. The date for achieving Substantial Completion of the Work shall be as set forth in the Special Conditions. Failure to achieve Substantial Completion of the Work within the Contract Time shall subject the Contractor to Liquidated Damages as set forth in the Special Conditions.

7. Payment and Performance Bonds. A Labor and Materials Payment Bond and Performance Bond are required in the amount of 100% of the Contract amount.

8. Prevailing Wage Rates. The Contractor and all Subcontractors performing any portion of the Work shall pay not less than the applicable prevailing wage rate for the classification of labor provide by their respective workers in prosecution and execution of the Work. Pursuant to Labor Code §1773, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the generally prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which the Work is to be performed. Copies of these determinations, entitled "PREVAILING WAGE SCALE" are available on the Internet at www.dir.ca.gov/dir/S&R/statistics_research.html. The Contractor awarded the Contract for the Work shall post a copy of all applicable prevailing wage rates for the Work at conspicuous locations at the Site of the Work.

9. Substitute Security. Substitution of eligible and equivalent securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure the Contractor's performance under the Contract will be permitted at the request and expense of the Contractor and in conformity with Public Contract Code §22300. The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded shall have thirty (30) days following award of the Contract to such Bidder to submit its written request to the District to permit the substitution of securities for retention. The failure of the Bidder to make such written request to the District within said thirty (30) day period shall be deemed a waiver of the Bidder's rights under Public Contract Code §22300.

10. Award of Contract. The Contract for the Work, if awarded, will be by action of the District's Board of Directors to the responsible Bidder submitting the lowest priced responsive Bid Proposal.
