Do you want the Construction Manager to assist with the permitting process?

Yes. The Construction Manager should coordinate with the General Contractor and Design Team to provide information and documentation for all applicable agency permits, inspections and plan reviews.

Does the 510 building have emergency power?

There is no central emergency power system. Emergency lighting is provided by battery-powered exit signs.
