Attendees will learn why early planning matters, how decision-making authority is established, and what legal tools may help protect a loved one's wishes and future care needs. Topics will include powers of attorney, advance health care directives, trusts, wills, estate planning, capacity considerations, and long-term care planning, including care at home, assisted living, memory care, and Medi-Cal considerations.

Designed for spouses, adult children, family caregivers, care partners, and aging services professionals, this workshop will help families better understand their options, reduce confusion, prevent conflict, and approach dementia care with greater clarity and confidence.
