Beach Cities Health District (BCHD) is in the process of creating a Healthy Living Campus on the District's Redondo Beach property located at 514 North Prospect Avenue. When completed, the 11-acre site will be a hub of well-being that serves and connects Beach Cities residents – ranging from children and families to adults and older adults – with abundant health and wellness services, programs and facilities.

Beach Cities Health District (BCHD) has served the people who live and work in Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach since 1955. Today, BCHD offers more than 40 free community health programs and services that promote wellness and prevent diseases across the entire lifespan.

BCHD has been working closely with the community since 2017 to reimagine our medical campus – home to our 60 year-old former hospital building located at 514 North Prospect Avenue – into an intergenerational Healthy Living Campus. Since May 2017, BCHD has held more than 60 meetings, drawing more than 1,000 comments regarding ways to modernize its property.

Comprehensive Master Plan Approach

BCHD is in the process of transforming our Redondo Beach property into a modernized Healthy Living Campus, an intergenerational hub that focuses on wellness and prevention for current and future Beach Cities generations.



allcove Beach Cities



allcove is an integrated service model for youth ages 12-25, including:

- mental health
- physical health
- substance use
- peer support
- family support
- supported education
- employment and social service referrals

The focus on mild-to-moderate mental health issues is a key component of what sets this model apart from existing sources of mental health care, since depression and anxiety are among the highest prevalence for youth, and early intervention is essential to preventing more serious health and academic outcomes

Non-Medical Home Care

Non-medical home care assists older adults who need help with activities of daily living (ADLs)

- Assistance in your home
- Personalized care overseen by professional caregivers
- Assistance with ADLs (e.g., bathing, dressing)
- Light housekeeping services
- Transportation

Residential Care for the Elderly (RCFE)

RCFEs are care facilities that optimize the health, safety and quality of life for older adults.

- Room and housing
- 24-hours per day personalized care overseen by professional staff
- Three meals a day and snacks
- Activity programs and outings
- Housekeeping services
- Maintenance services
- Transportation

Annual average cost of care for 24 hours per day \$324,000

Annual average cost of care \$54,000 - \$144,000

RCFE facilities include assisted living and memory care, both are proposed in the Master Plan for BCHD's Healthy Living Campus. Today, BCHD has 60 units/120 beds of memory care on its campus.
